



Terms and Conditions

All players taking part in any Adrenaline Beach Tennis session implicitly agree with and shall be bound by the terms and conditions of Adrenaline Beach Tennis (ABT)

Membership and Payments

- ABT reserve the right to adjust the pricing and availability of Membership subscriptions.
- Membership and Multipacks entitle the player to join any regular ABT session (times subject to change). Tournaments and special events are subject to additional charge
- Summer Membership period runs between the 1st June and 30th September 2024
- Full Year Membership period runs between the 1st June 2024 and 31st March 2025
- Memberships are not transferrable.
- ABT reserves the right to accept, refuse or terminate a membership.
- Payment for membership is payable in advance by Bank Transfer.

Multipacks and Payments

- Multipacks can be used as credit for 10 regular ABT sessions up to the 31st March.
- ABT reserve the right to adjust the pricing and availability of Multipacks.
- Players will be informed when the multipack has been completed or expired.
- Should, for any reason, the sand courts be closed for maintenance or refurbishment for a period of more than 4 weeks the deadline of the multipacks will be extended in lieu of lost playing time.
- Multipacks are not transferrable
- ABT reserves the right to accept, refuse or terminate a Multipack.
- If you are in repeated breach of the ABT code of conduct and any ABT terms and conditions your Multipack may be terminated without refund.
- Payment for multipacks is payable in advance by Bank Transfer.

Pay as You Play and Payments

- By attending an ABT managed session you agree to abide by ABT Terms and Conditions and Code of Conduct.
- ABT reserve the right to adjust the pricing and availability of Pay as You Play session fees.
- If you are in repeated breach of the ABT code of conduct and any ABT terms and conditions you may be denied access to ABT sessions.
- Payment for Pay as You Play is payable by bank transfer or NatWest Pay It within 48 hours of attending the session.

- Repeated failure to pay, or pay on time, may result in being banned from attending ABT sessions for an unspecified period or indefinitely. Such sanctions are at the discretion of the ABT committee.

Termination of Memberships

- You may terminate your Membership by giving 30 days notice in writing if you are unable to use the facilities through serious illness or injury unlikely to preclude you from using the facilities for a period of at least 2 calendar months.
- You may also terminate your Membership if:
 - a) We significantly reduce session times (by more than 50%).
 - b) The sand courts are closed for maintenance or refurbishment for a period of more than 4 weeks at a time.
- We will use our reasonable endeavours to give you at least 30 days notice of the change. Memberships will be extended in lieu of any time the facilities are not available for a period of more than 4 weeks. If you wish to terminate your membership due to the reasons stated above, you can give us 30 days notice in writing to terminate.
- If you terminate your membership (in accordance with the terms stated above) we will refund any part of your membership fee, which you have paid in advance but which relates to a period after termination.
- If you are in repeated breach of the ABT code of conduct and any ABT terms and conditions your membership may be terminated without refund.

Data Protection

- Under the terms and conditions of the Data Protections Act 1984 we are required to inform you that membership information is held on a computer
- All photographic and video content is held securely in accordance with data protection law

Photo & Video Consent

- The club has an active social media presence and a website. From time to time, to keep the club's profile up to date and to attract new members, we share videos and/or photographs of our sessions, matches and other events.
- All content and images on the ABT website and social media remain the property of ABT and may not be downloaded or reproduced without permission of ABT.
- **If you do not wish for your pictures to be included, please make sure you inform us immediately.**

Insurance & Personal Liability

- ABT holds professional and public liability insurance
- Players join ABT sessions at entirely their own risk. Beach Tennis is not inherently dangerous, but accidents can happen and players must look out for themselves and others when playing. A first Aid kit is held in the ABT kit bag.
- ABT will not accept any responsibility for direct personal injury or consequential loss.
- Our liability to compensate you (in the case of loss or damage other than death or personal injury) is limited to a reasonable amount having regard

to such factors as whether the damage was due to a negligent act or omission by us.

- We will compensate you for any loss or damage you may suffer if we fail to carry out our obligations under this agreement or to a reasonable standard or breach any duties imposed on us by law (including if we cause the death or personal injury to you by your own negligence) unless that failure is attributable to:
 - a) your own fault
 - b) a third party unconnected with our provision of service under the agreement ; or
 - c) events which neither we nor our suppliers could have foreseen or forestalled even if we had taken all reasonable care.
- All players accept they are medically fit to undertake strenuous exercise. If in doubt consult your doctor before embarking on an exercise routine and use of all our facilities shall be undertaken at the member's own risk without any recourse on ABT.

Safeguarding

- ABT is committed to safeguarding the well-being of all players, both adults and children. A safeguarding policy is in place and available on the website.
- Any safeguarding concerns should be reported to the safeguarding officer.
- Under 16s are strictly not permitted to participate in any sessions unless they are supervised at all times by parent or guardian.

Etiquette

- All players agree to comply with ABT Terms and Conditions and Code of Conduct, a copy of which can be found on the website. We may (unless stated elsewhere in this agreement) make reasonable changes to these rules at any time provided we give you notice of the changes.
- Details of the facilities' current session times are displayed in the Whatsapp group details.
- Any person arriving in a state of inebriation will not be admitted.
- Players must show consideration for one another in and around the facilities. In particular, profane or abusive language and the threats or use of violence will not be tolerated.
- In the interest of safety, glass containers, jars and bottles are not allowed on the sand court facilities.
- Members must agree to follow all written and verbal instructions from ABT Committee and Session Crew members as systems or procedures may change from time to time.
- ABT may in its absolute discretion expel any player whose conduct is considered, in its opinion, to be injurious to the interest of other players. A player expelled shall forfeit any privileges and all rights against ABT.
